ABOUT THE HOSPITALS – HILLINGDON & MOUNT VERNON

We are the official charity for the Hillingdon & Mount Vernon Hospitals. Hillingdon Hospital is just up the road from Stockley Park, and is the main general & emergency hospital for this part of North West London, including Heathrow Airport and Stockley Park itself.

The hospital looks after people of all ages, from 5000 newborn babies per year, a neonatal unit which looks after premature and very unwell newborn babies, 3 specialist children's wards, and a dedicated children's accident & emergency department, all the way through to specialist dementia friendly wards for frail older people. Hillingdon Hospitals provide a range of specialist departments including surgery, cancer care, and is one of the busiest A&E departments in London.

Mount Vernon Hospital has a modern Diagnostic and Treatment Centre. These house four state-of-the-art operating theatres for elective surgery. We recently saw the expansion of our highly-regarded neuro-rehabilitation service as we opened the new 16-bed Daniels Ward. There is also outpatient services minor injuries unit, spacious waiting area, coffee shop and onsite taxi service.
